FIELD APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

TIMING:
Apply at 7 - 14 days interval until deficiency symptoms disappear.

RATES:
Citrus & Grapes - Apply 32 to 40 ounces per acre.
Apples & Pears - Apply 32 to 40 ounces per acre.
Stone Fruits - Apply 28 to 40 ounces per acre.
Horticulture - Apply 24 to 32 ounces per acre.
Roses & other Flowers - Apply 24 to 32 ounces per acre.
Processing & Tuber Crops - Apply 32 to 40 ounces per acre.
Ornamentals - Apply 24 to 32 ounces per acre.
Turf - Apply 4 to 6 ounces per 1000 sq.ft.

DIRECTIONS FOR MIXING

BREXIL Combi is a soluble product to be mixed with water. Select a water volume and corresponding rate of **BREXIL Combi** necessary to thoroughly spray/mist all fruit and foliage surfaces. Gradually add the recommended amount of product to a half-filled spray tank and mix, then add the balance of required water while continuing to agitate the solution.

CLEANING OF SPRAYER

Flush with clean water all parts of the sprayer including the pump, hoses and nozzles several times prior to and after the use of this product.
