

**Note to Physician:** Trichlorfon is an organophosphate. Prolonged exposure will cause cholinesterase depression. Atropine Sulfate is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

BEFORE YOU USE Read and follow these Directions when using:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Do not apply near fish ponds, ponds, streams or lakes.</li> <li>• Do not apply to waterlogged soil.</li> <li>• Water grass as soon as possible after application to move product to root zone where insects feed.</li> <li>• Do not allow children or pets on treated lawn until grass has been watered and allowed to dry.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Children and pets may re-enter only after the treated area has been watered and allowed to dry.</li> </ul>

HOW TO USE	
<b>GRUBS</b>	Apply when Grubs are present.
<b>MOLE CRICKETS</b>	Apply when Mole Crickets are present.
<b>CUTWORMS AND SOD WEBWORMS</b>	Mid-May through Mid-June.
<b>LAWNS</b>	<p><b>How Much:</b> See Spreader Settings.</p> <p>Adjust spreader to the proper settings.</p> <p>To be sure you cover the entire area uniformly, first treat the border of the Lawn then fill in the center. Make parallel passes, walking at a steady pace to ensure even distribution of the granules.</p> <p>Water thoroughly after applying.</p>

FOR BEST RESULTS	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The best time to kill Grubs is July through September, when they are young and actively feeding near the soil surface.</li> <li>• Water thoroughly within 24 hours after applying.</li> <li>• Do not mow until the granules are watered in to the soil.</li> <li>• Avoid applying HI-YIELD<sup>®</sup> DYLOX<sup>®</sup> 6.2 GRANULAR INSECTICIDE to waterlogged areas, as this may decrease the product's effectiveness.</li> <li>• You may spread HI-YIELD<sup>®</sup> DYLOX<sup>®</sup> 6.2 GRANULAR INSECTICIDE over soil or mulch. If present, remove Weed Barrier before applying.</li> </ul>	

SIGNS OF DAMAGE TO LAWNS	
<b>GRUBS</b>	White Grubs cause extensive damage to Lawns by feeding on Grass roots. Grass turns yellow, then brown and dies. Grubs chew off the roots so that the Grass is easily pulled up in places with your hands. You can roll it back like a carpet to reveal the Grubs. If patches of dead Grass appeared in your Lawn late last Summer, check for Grubs.
<b>MOLE CRICKETS</b>	Mole Crickets often cause extensive damage by tunneling through Lawns. Some species also feed on roots. Tunneling uproots the Grass so it easily dries out. Lawns turn yellow, become thin, weedy and can eventually die.
<b>CUTWORMS AND SOD WEBWORMS</b>	Sod Webworms and Cutworms damage Lawns by cutting blades of Grass near the ground. Small brown patches will appear. Cutworms can also be seen in the Lawn. Webworms nest down in the thatch layer, coming up to feed at night.
<b>HOW IT WORKS</b>	HI-YIELD <sup>®</sup> DYLOX <sup>®</sup> 6.2 GRANULAR INSECTICIDE is intended to be used when insects and Grubs are present. After granules are watered in, insects are killed on contact. The active ingredient degrades quickly.

If after placing the correct amount of product in spreader to cover the area to be treated, and application has been made, and there remains product in spreader, **uniformly** apply remaining product at right angles over the treated area.  
**Note:** 1,000 sq. ft. = 20 ft. X 50 ft.  
 Do not use a spreader that applies granules in narrow, concentrated, or uneven bands. Be sure the spreader works properly and spreads granules evenly.
